ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER

The Court hereby adopts the following administrative order.

The Court adopts the following time limits and procedures to govern the order of criminal cases to be tried before this Court for the October 2022 Jury Term.

With respect to the October 2022 Jury Term, it shall be the responsibility of Tribal Prosecutor's Office to provide to the Public Defender/opposing counsel a written proposal of the order of cases to be tried by October 3, 2022. This written proposal shall contain the case name and number, along with a numerical ranking of the Tribal Prosecutor's preference for the order in which the cases shall be tried. The Public Defender's Office/opposing counsel shall provide a written response to the proposed order by October 5, 2022, setting forth its proposed order of cases. Thereafter, counsel shall confer to determine whether an agreement can be reached regarding the order of cases to be tried, and if not, the parties shall file with the Court a written notice by October 7, 2022. The Court will set a hearing to take up the issue of trial order for October 10, 2022 at 8:30 am.

The trial of defendants in custody solely because they are awaiting trial should be given preference over other cases.

Future jury term procedures will be governed by AO-2022-6.
