

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

This matter came on for hearing seeking original jurisdiction on a Writ of Mandamus and Prohibition to address issues involving the Tribal Election Board regarding the 2019 Tribal Council Election for District 11 Council Seat.


The Tribal Council has granted to the Constitutional Court exclusive appellate jurisdiction regarding all election matters. Tribal Election Code, Article XIX, Section 8. The Constitutional Court has previously ruled in this matter in CC 19-1, decided 8/1/19.

Since the Tribal Council has not granted this Court appellate or original jurisdiction for election contests, pursuant to Section 1.108 (C), Act Establishing a Court of General Jurisdiction for Choctaw Nation of Oklahoma, and the Council has granted exclusive appellate jurisdiction to the Constitutional Court, we must therefore dismiss the Application for lack of jurisdiction in this Court.

IT IS SO ORDERED.
